TERMS & CONDITIONS OF CHAMPIONSHIPS**GENERAL**

- The SuperJuniors is open to all young golfers from ages **4 to 12 years of age as at 1st Aug for the year of this event**
- All players must possess a valid handicap card, a proficiency certificate or a certification letter from a recognized golf academy in Singapore.
- Finals of the SuperJuniors will be played over two days, with Qualifying rounds conducted prior to the Finals.
- The Organizing Committee reserves full rights to accept, reject any registrations and to determine the final number of players for the SuperJuniors.
- The SuperJuniors is played in accordance with the Rules of Golf as approved by Royal & Ancient Club of St. Andrews, United States Golf Association and Local Rules of the National Service Golf & Country Club.
- The Tournament Director, appointed by the Organizing Committee, shall have the sole management and control of the SuperJuniors, to alter any Terms & Conditions and to decide on any disputes or queries arising out of the Championships. **The Tournament Director's decision on all matters related to the SuperJuniors shall be final.**

LOCATION (Subject to change)

- The SuperJuniors will be conducted at the Executive Par-3 Golf Course at the National Service Resort & Country Club, 10 Changi Coast Walk, Singapore 499739 (www.nsrcc.com.sg).

REGISTRATION, CLOSING DATE & PAYMENT

- All registrations and payments must be submitted by the **CLOSING DATE**.
- Registrations must be made on the Official Registration Form and submitted with full payment AND copies of supporting documents prior to the closing date at any of the KinderGolf and partners outlets in Singapore. (See www.superjuniors.com for the latest list). You will be issued with an Official Receipt upon collection of your form and payment.
- Payment modes accepted are cash and credit card.
- One form per player. Each form to be completed in full. **Incomplete forms risk non-participation.**
- All entrants will be informed of their registrations latest within 1 week of the closing date.
- Date change request must be emailed to superjuniors@kindergolf.com. All request subject to availability and at the sole discretion of organizing team. **Requests after closing date is subject to S\$30 administrative fee.**

FORMAT OF PLAY

- The Championship comprises of 2 stages, Qualifiers and Finals.
- Qualifiers
 - Each player will play 1 round of 9 holes (Par3) during each Qualifier. Results will be tabulated across all the Qualifiers and the Organizing Committee will determine the players making the shortlist ("the cut") into the Finals based on the lowest scores. Div E play 1 round of 4 holes (Par3).
 - Players are allowed to participate in more than one Qualifier. The best score of the player will be taken into consideration for selection into the Finals.
- Finals
 - There are two days in the Finals and each player will play 1 round of 9 holes (Par3) over 2 consecutive days. Div E play 4 holes (Par3) per round.
 - Scores from Day 1, Day 2 and Finals will be summed as the final score of each Player. The player with the lowest score will be the champion for the division.

TIMESHEET

- All players will tee-off according to the timesheet decided solely by the organizing committee with no exception.

YARDAGE AND TEEBOX COLORS

- Yardage is set according to age group / gender and will be indicated by different color tee box markers.
- As a guide for each round of 9 holes, the yardage is between 350m to 1000m for Boys and between 200 to 850m for Girls / Family.

SCORING

- Scoring for the Championship is Stroke Play and gross score is used.
- It is the responsibility of the player to ensure that the correct score is recorded in the scorecard. Personal integrity is a hallmark of golf. **Incorrect score will result in immediate disqualification of the player.**
- Each player will be assigned a marker to record the correct score of another player in the flight after each hole. After completion of the round, the player shall
 - Check his hole-by-hole score for accuracy with the marker
 - Settle any disputes or doubtful points with the Organizing Committee
 - Ensure that his marker has signed his card properly
 - Countersign his own card, and
 - Submit the card to the Organizing Committee immediately after completion of the round.
- All Players shall take no more than 8 strokes on any hole, beyond which they will pick up their ball and register 8 as the maximum score for that hole. Prior to start of play, all scorecards are to be exchanged within the players in the flight and scores recorded by the player's markers. The player or his caddy will not record his score directly on his scorecard.
- Ties and Alternates. All ties in the individual age group will be broken by a scorecard playoff, starting with the last hole played and going backwards on the card.

PRIZES & AWARDS

- Prizes will be awarded to the top 3 winners of each division.
- All players, irrespective of placing, will receive a Certificate of Participation and a Goodie Bag.

OVERSEAS PLAYERS

- Overseas players are welcome to participate in the SuperJuniors. All terms and conditions of the SuperJuniors apply for overseas players.
- For overseas players, the country's golf association or union must verify the handicap card, PC or certification letter.

ENTRY FEES

- Qualifier Fee
 - This is the fee for one child player (Division A, B, C, D or E) or one child player and 1 adult player (Division F) to compete in one qualifier. Players are allowed to compete to more than one qualifier. Best score of each player will be considered as the selection criteria for the Finals.
- Registration Fee
 - This is a registration fee for all players.
- Finals Fee
 - This is the fee for one child player (Division A, B, C, D or E) or one child player plus 1 adult player (Division F) to compete in the Finals.
- There is NO REFUND of the fees after the closing date.

SIGN-IN & BRIEFING

- All players must **sign-in at least 45 minutes before their schedule tee-time**. All players must bring originals of their handicap cards, proficiency certificates and/or certification letters from their golf academies. **Failure to do so will result in non-participation in the SuperJuniors.**
- A Safety & Rules Briefing will be conducted 30 minutes prior to the commencement of each round.
- It is mandatory for all players and parents are to be present for this briefing. **Latecomers to this briefing will result in a two strokes penalty to the score of the player. Absentees from this briefing will result in a six strokes penalty added to the score of the player.**
- Each player must be at the **starting tee-box at least 10 minutes before scheduled tee-off**. **Players who miss their scheduled tee-off times will NOT be allowed to join the flight.**

PACE OF PLAY

- Rule 6-7 (R&A) will be strictly enforced. Each flight must maintain its position on the course with respect to the group preceding it. Any group with a clear hole in front of it will be considered out of position. Penalties (two strokes per occurrence) will be issued to individuals in such groups who, by their pace, contribute to such delay. Warnings need not be issued prior to penalties.

CADDIES

- Caddies. **All Players must have a caddy who must be a parent, grandparent, sibling or relative.** All Players will walk and play the course with their appointed caddies. Hand drawn trolleys will be provided for the players.

EQUIPMENT

- Players must bring and use their own golf clubs, bags and other equipment necessary for play. No sharing of equipment is allowed.
- Approved Balls. Only those appearing on the current R&A List of Conforming Golf Balls may be used. Penalty for breach is disqualification.

DISQUALIFICATION & DISPUTES

- Disqualification. Players and caddies must observe the terms and conditions of this tournament. Non-compliance will result in disqualification of the player and caddy.
- Any disputes must be made with the Tournament Director within 15 minutes of the completion of the round. All decisions by the Tournament Director shall be final.

INCLEMENT WEATHER

- Inclement weather. The Tournament Director shall decide on the most appropriate actions and score computation related to weather delays and/or cancellations on site, the day of the event. If a delay occurs, it is the player's responsibility to be ready when play resumes. **All decisions by the Tournament Director shall be final.**

CODE OF CONDUCT

- Code of conduct. Violations of the code of conduct include: abusive language, club throwing, cheating, disrespect of volunteers, officials or marshals, abuse to the golf course or the facility, littering, or any other conduct unbecoming of a tournament Player will result in disqualification and barring of the player from the SuperJuniors. This applies to both the players and the parent/caddy.
- No Smoking. Smoking is **STRICTLY NOT ALLOWED** on the course. Violation, by accompanying parents, caddies and adults will result in the players' immediate disqualification.
- No Handphones. Handphones must be set to silent mode or off. Violation will result in disqualification of the player and the eviction of the offender from the course.

DRESS CODE

- Dress code: **All players and caddies MUST BE in proper accepted golf attire and golf shoes (soft-spikes).** Players in inappropriate attire such as short shorts, swimwear, denim of any kind, t-shirts, tank tops, sandals and shoes with metal spikes will not be allowed to participate.

VOLUNTEERS

- To further involve more parents and supporters, in particular the non-golfers, the committee seeks active volunteers to help in various components of the event, including registration management, safety marshals, refreshment replenishment, etc. There will be briefings for all organizing committee members, sponsors, caddies and volunteers prior to the start of the event.
