KinderGolf is a unique preschooler golf instructional environment specially designed to groom the next generation of very good golfers. All KinderGolfers are taught solid golf fundamentals, proper golf etiquette, rules, respect for the game, and at the same time, important mental and life skills like discipline, focus, confidence, integrity are nurtured as part of the learning. KinderGolf was founded in Singapore in 2000, has 9 locations and has introduced thousands of preschoolers to the game.
